

How to play

1. Pick the cards you want your child to share their opinion on today.
2. Mix them and place the cards in a pile, face down.
3. Let your child turn one card at a time and place it next to the slice that shows "what they think about it".
4. If your child feels talkative, gently ask them to tell you more about it.
5. Stay neutral and supportive. Whatever your child says, receive it with warmth — no fixing.
6. End with gratitude: "Thank you for telling me. I love hearing what you think."
